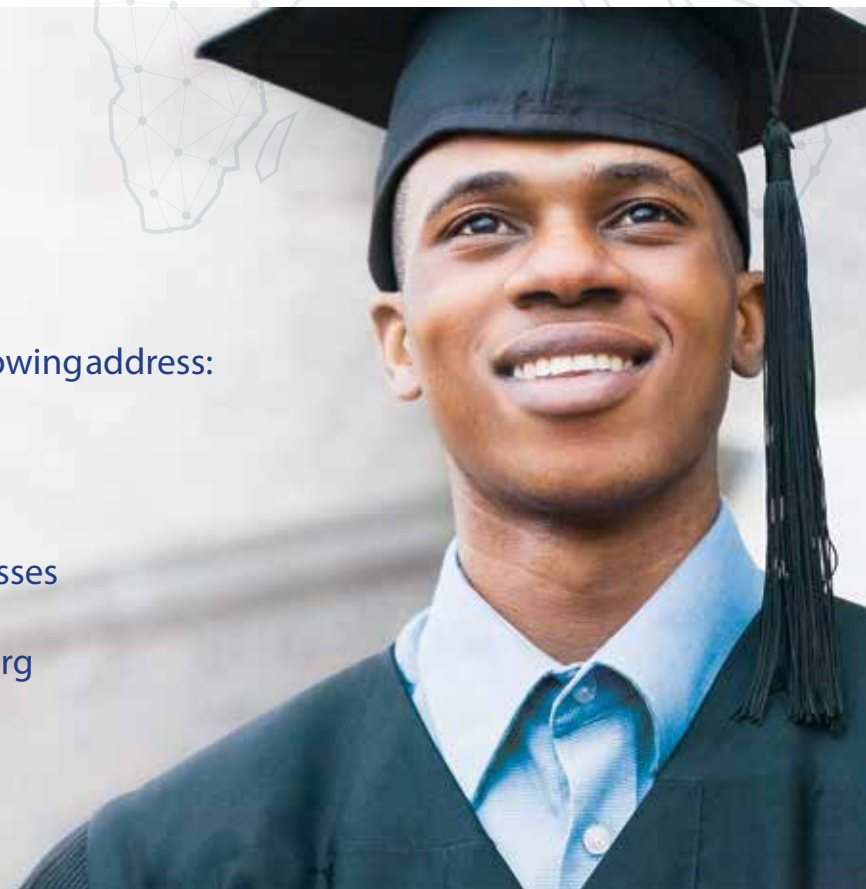

MASTERS CERTIFICATE IN MANAGEMENT OF PUBLIC PRIVATE PARTNERSHIPS- 3P

OBJECTIVE

This graduate level certification offered by University Laval and IDEA International Institute aims to build your capacity for analysis and synthesis, and enhance your competencies in designing, selecting and managing Public-Private partnership (3Ps). It will also enable you to master concepts and methodologies for: 1) The identification of projects susceptible to be conducted using a 3P modality; 2) The elaboration, evaluation of options, and implementation of 3P projects; and 3) The transaction and management of 3P contracts. The scope of the program covers a variety of sectors using 3P modalities, including transportation, renewable energy, logistics, social sectors, etc. It is not designed for a specific sector or region of the world, even though case studies can be selected to cater to the interests of specific groups of participants.

TARGET AUDIENCE

This graduate level certification is intended for you, managers and professionals working in 3P units in national and local governments, technical and financial partners and private sector professionals who participating in processes of 3P design, ex ante evaluation, management and monitoring, and/or ex post evaluation. This program oriented more toward managers and decision-makers is complementary to the Certified PPP Professional (CP3P) certification offered by APMG International which trains young and intermediate professionals on the fundamentals of 3Ps.

To participate, you must hold an undergraduate university degree in engineering, public administration, business administration, law, economics, or a related field and you will need to have acquired at least three years of professional experience in the public sector or in projects.

STRUCTURE OF THE PROGRAM

This program includes 3 modules:

Module 1 : Screening of P3 projects;

Module 2 : Structuring 3P projects ;

Module 3 : Managing 3P projects.

To obtain this graduate level certification, the participant must have fulfilled the requirements of the three modules. Each module includes 60 hours of coursework and working group assignments, 7 hours of readings and individual integration project for a total of 201 hours for the entire program. Each module is offered either in mixed modality (2 weeks part-time at a distance and one week face-to-face) or at a distance modality (4 weeks part time). A passing grade of 60/100 is required for two individual evaluations, 3 to 4 working group assignments and the individual integration projects.

Participants who fail to obtain the required grade for one of the modules will be awarded only an attendance certificate and not a Masters certificate.

A participant interested in obtaining regular credits in the Master's program in Organizational Development of University Laval must complete, in addition to the 201 hours, an in-depth integration project of 70 hours that will be supervised by a senior professional of the IDEA Institute or by a professor of the University Laval.

This project will be evaluated and the participant must demonstrate his ability to integrate the knowledge acquired during the three modules.
